## **NOTICE OF SUSPENSION**

On April 6, 2004, a Hearing Committee accepted the Statement of Facts and Admission of Guilt made by **Mr. Parry McDonald** on two citations. Mr. McDonald resides and practised in Lethbridge, Alberta.

Mr. McDonald admitted his guilt, pursuant to Section 60 of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, on two citations involving failing to honour an undertaking.

The Hearing Committee ordered that the member be reprimanded and suspended for an indefinite period of time until the member has satisfied a Board of Examiners that his competence to practice law is not adversely affected by his addiction to drugs. That the member shall pay the actual costs of the hearing on or before October 6, 2004. It further ordered that the member pay all costs associated with his recovery in relation to any monitoring or testing that may be required.

There was no direction to appoint a custodian as Mr. McDonald has been inactive since September 23, 2002.
