Suspension

On April 16, 2007 a Hearing Committee found that the conduct of **Gerald Smith**, who resides and practices in Edmonton, Alberta, was deserving of sanction in that he lied to and misled a client, and failed to serve the client. Mr. Smith admitted that, over a period of approximately 18 months, he lied to and misled his client regarding his failure to take certain steps in a litigation matter.

The Hearing Committee directed, pursuant to section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, that the membership of **Mr. Smith** be suspended for 30 days commencing April 20, 2007. The Hearing Committee further ordered that, upon the conclusion of the suspension, **Mr. Smith** must continue to practice as an employee of an approved employer for five years or until relieved of the restriction by the Executive Director. **Mr. Smith** is required to pay the actual costs of the hearing, estimated to be \$2,851.40.
