Suspension

On July 24, 2017, a Hearing Committee of the Law Society of Alberta found the conduct of Terrance Dawe, a member of the Law Society who lives and practices in Calgary, Alberta, to be deserving of sanction on two citations and, pursuant to section 72(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Act* R.S.A. 2000, c. L-8, ordered that Mr. Dawe will be suspended for 14 days, commencing July 29, 2017.

Mr. Dawe was found guilty of failing to properly supervise his staff and failing to conduct himself as a reasonable and prudent solicitor, which enabled his clients and others to achieve an improper purpose.

The following lawyer will assume carriage of Mr. Dawe's practice during the period of suspension:
