## IN THE MATTER OF A HEARING REGARDING THE CONDUCT OF STEPHEN KACZKOWSKI A MEMBER OF THE LAW SOCIETY OF ALBERTA

## **DISPOSITION SUMMARY – HE20180048**

Stephen Kaczkowski admitted guilt on five citations relating to two complaints. With respect to the first complaint, he admitted that he failed to comply with Rules 118.3, 118.4, 118.6, 118.7, 119.20, 119.25, 119.36(4)(d) and 119.40 of the Rules of the Law Society of Alberta, and that this was conduct deserving of sanction. On the second complaint, he admitted that he was in error when he advised his client that a Consent Order could not be appealed, and that this conduct deserved sanction.

A Statement of Agreed Facts and Admission of Guilt was accepted by a Conduct Committee Panel pursuant to section 60(2) of the *Legal Profession Act*.

The Hearing Committee accepted the joint submission on sanction that Mr. Kaczkowski be reprimanded, fined \$2,500.00, and pay costs of \$4,403.05. The reprimand was delivered orally at the hearing.
